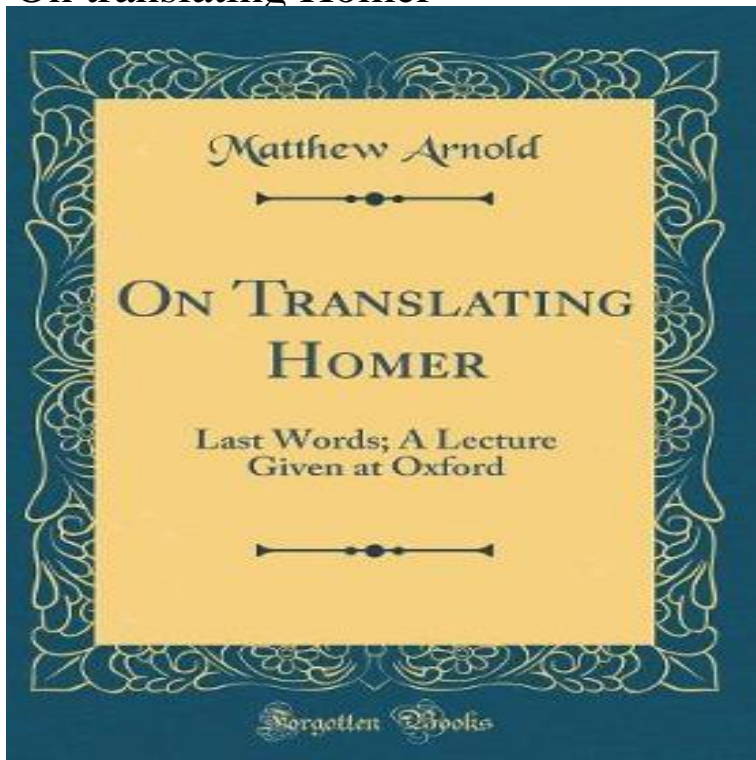


# On translating Homer
