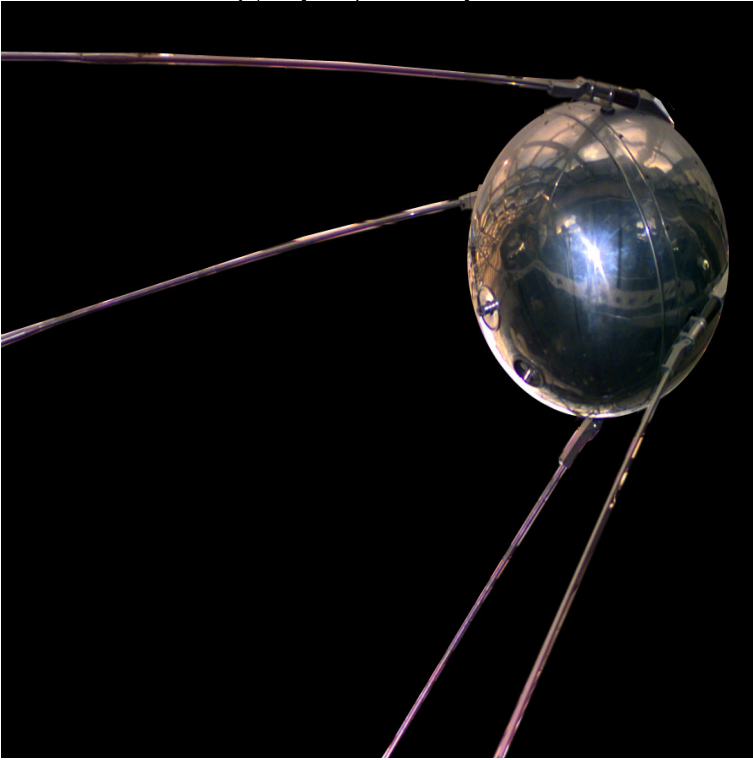

Early United States Space Policy: A Critique of the Historiography of Space. The Space Race refers to the 20th-century competition between two Cold War rivals, the Soviet Union and the United States. The "race" peaked with the July 20, 1969, US landing of the first humans on the Moon. A coherent space policy began to take shape in the United States during the late 1950s and early 1960s. The Soviet Union had launched the first artificial satellite, a new moon, on Oct. 4, 1957. Sputnik plunged Americans into a crisis of self-confidence.
